Specialty Recycling at the Recycling Center

The CCSWD continues to hold its Household Hazardous Waste collection on Thursdays 9am - 6pm and the first Saturday of each month from 9am - 12pm at 1620 W. Main St. The cost for household hazardous waste is \$1.00 per pound. Paint is \$0.30 per pound. See 32trash.org for a full list of items and fees if applicable. No appointment necessary.

Community Cleanup Trailer & ClearStream Frames

The Community Cleanup trailer is available through November 15th for loan free of charge to Clark County residents and community volunteer groups (minimum of 5 households or groups with at least 5 adult volunteers). The trailer is stocked with landscaping tools to help residents with trimming overgrown lots, removing debris, and otherwise improving Clark County neighborhoods.

Styrofoam Recycling now Available

The Clark County Solid Waste District continues to recycle expanded polystyrene (EPS) packaging better known as Styrofoam. The densified foam is recycled to make new products, like picture frames and crown molding. Individuals can drop-off packaging Styrofoam in our container located at 1620 W. Main St. in Springfield. How Does It Work?
You bring your unwanted furniture item. The item is measured using a 4' x 4' template. If the item is smaller than the template, it costs \$5 to dispose of. If the item is larger than the template, it costs \$10 to dispose of.

Large Item \$10 Disposal Fee
